

Connecting to FlashZone WPA  
MAC 10.4 or 10.5

**NOTE: If you have Version 10.3 or below, your version of OS X is out-of-date and unsupported by Apple. You will need to purchase an upgrade to 10.5 to access the wireless system.**

**To determine your version, click on the Apple Menu in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, and choose *About this Mac*. The window that pops up will have your version number.**

1. First go to <http://flashword.kent.edu> and enter your FlashLine username. Click "Use a password". Enter your FlashLine Password. You MUST click "Pick a new password" you MUST change your password to a new one. What you enter here will change your FlashLine and Vista/Webct password.
2. After that is done go back to Kent State Stark home page [www.stark.kent.edu](http://www.stark.kent.edu) and log into FlashLine. Logging into FlashLine will synchronize the information you just entered in flashword.
3. Make sure that your AirPort Wireless Card is enabled. In the upper right corner of your desktop, click the wireless icon and make sure the AirPort is **ON**. If it is **OFF**, click the option **Turn AirPort On**.
4. Receive the wireless configuration utility off of a flashdrive from the East Wing Computer lab or Download the XpressConnect wireless configuration utility from <http://flashzone.kent.edu/flashzone.dmg> or stop at the Library, Campus Center information desk, or the East Wing Computer lab.
5. Save the file (**flashzone.dmg**) to your desktop.
6. Double-click **flashzone.dmg** on your desktop to launch the utility. The icon will look like the image below:
7. The installer will launch and extract its contents. Double-click the FlashZone icon to launch the configuration utility.
8. Click **Trust** in the window to accept the signed certificate.
9. Please read the installer notes. When finished, click **Continue**
10. Enter your Flashline username and password. Click **Continue**

**Note: Your username does not require "@kent.edu" to be appended to it.**

11. Enter your Username and password for your Mac's Administrative Account. Click **OK**

**Note: This is NOT your Flashline username and password.**

12. Next, you will be asked whether or not you will allow the credentials to be used from your Mac's keychain. Click **Allow**.

13. You should see the window acknowledge that it has successfully configured and associated with FlashZone-WPA.

14. If you have successfully authenticated to the network, the below window will appear.

This message alerts you that it is now attempting to obtain a network address.

15. When the configuration process has completed and you have been assigned a Network Address (IP Address), the below window will appear.
