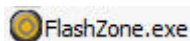


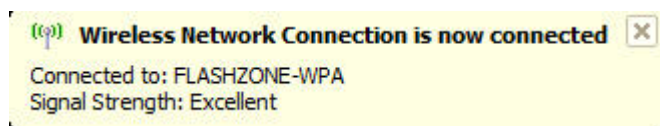
Connecting to Flashzone-WPA
Windows XP Service Pack 2/3 and Vista

1. First go to <http://flashword.kent.edu> and enter your FlashLine username. Click "Use a password". Enter your FlashLine Password. You MUST click "Pick a new password" you MUST change your password to a new one. What you enter here will change your FlashLine and Vista/Webct password.
2. After that is done go back to Kent State Stark home page www.stark.kent.edu and log into FlashLine. Logging into FlashLine will synchronize the information you just entered in flashword.
3. Receive the wireless configuration utility off of a flashdrive from the East Wing Computer lab or Download the XpressConnect wireless configuration utility from <http://flashzone.kent.edu/flashzone.exe> or stop at the Library, East Wing Computer lab, or Campus Center Information Desk
4. Save the file (**flashzone.exe**) to your desktop.
5. Double-click **flashzone.exe** on your desktop to launch the utility. The icon will look like the image below:



6. The wireless configuration utility will launch.
7. Please read the installer notes. When finished, click **Continue**
8. Enter your Flashline username and password. Click **Continue**
Note: Your username does not require "@kent.edu" to be appended to it.
9. The XpressConnect utility will now attempt to connect to the Flashzone-WPA network and automatically configure the options for you.
10. If you have successfully authenticated to the network, a bubble will appear in the lower right side of your computer.

This will advise you that you have successfully been configured to the wireless network.



*11. If you receive the below error message, this implies that you have incorrectly entered your username and password in Step 8. Click **Change Username and password** to return to Step 8.



1. After you clear Step 8 (Authentication), the utility will now receive it's Network Address.
2. When the configuration process has completed and you have been assigned a Network Address (IP Address), the below window will appear:
3. *Open* up a web browser to verify that you are connected.
